Matthew 10 describes the commissioning of the 12 disciples. In this passage, Jesus warns them to expect persecution. Why should the disciples expect persecution?


"Christians in Singapore hardly experience any persecution as compared with those in some other countries." Why is that so? How can we encourage and support fellow believers who face persecution in other countries?

"Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me..." - **Matthew 11:29 (ESV)**



"For whoever does the will of God, he is My brother and sister and mother." - Mark 3:35 (ESV)



"For whoever is ashamed of Me and of My words... the Son of Man also be ashamed when He comes..." - Mark 8:38 (ESV)



Verse 34 describes a disciple as one who "deny himself", "take up his cross", and "follow Me"? What would each of these phrases practically mean for you?




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FRIDAY

According to this passage, why is it difficult (though not impossible) for the wealthy to enter the kingdom of God?



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SATURDAY

"Follow Me..." - Luke 9:59 (ESV)

Luke 9:57-62 (Read)

Reflection Questions

Jesus's standard of a disciple is a high one (verse 62). What does it mean to "put one's hand into the plow and look back"? Why do you think this person is not fit for the kingdom of God?

Jesus spells out clearly to all who want to follow Him – it is going to be a tough journey involving much sacrifice. What are some dreams / goals / wants you have in your life which you are still struggling to lay at the foot of the cross?

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SUNDAY

"You shall be holy, for I am holy." - 1 Peter 1:16 (ESV)

1 Peter 1:13-25 (Read)

Reflection Questions

What does it mean to be "holy"? (see 2 Corinthians 6:3-10, 14-18)

How do you "conduct yourself with fear" in your daily life (v 17b)?

adjust.
Any other promptings from the Holy Spirit? (Words of encouragement, specific
