

Why did Gideon doubt that God was with him? (v 13)



What was the underlying reason that Eve ate the fruit? (v 6)



"How shall I know this? For I am an old man, and my wife is advanced in years." - Luke 1:18 (ESV)



## Reflection Questions


Imagine that you are Zechariah -what would you say to the angel in response to what he said to you?

"But You, O LORD, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who lifts up my head." - **Psalm 3:3 (NKJV)** 



## Reflection Questions


What situation was the Psalmist facing? (v 1-2) Was there a time you encountered a similar situation?

"Wives, in the same way submit yourselves to your own husbands..." - 1 Peter 3:1 (NIV)


