#### RESUMPTION OF IN-PERSON CELL MEETINGS

Gathering as one to worship God and experience His presence is not something we do, but who we are.

As we gradually resume in-person church gatherings, we are encouraging cell groups to resume meeting in-person.

- Cell groups may resume in-person meetings in multiple homes with five guests per home. Five excludes the host(s).
- Guidelines pertaining to visitors to households should be followed.
- Cell members who are unwell should participate virtually rather than inperson.

We have put together two resources to equip and help our cells to facilitate inperson cell meetings – a Cell Worship video resource as well as a Zoom guide for in-person meetings.

#### **CELL WORSHIP PROJECT**

A video resource specially put together for RiverLife cell groups to help facilitate a time of in-person worship. Each month, two worship sets led by our in-house worship team will be released on the first Wednesday of the month. Cells can use these videos for corporate cell worship in a home setting.

This guide aims to help cell groups facilitate in-person cell meetings in multiple homes.

There are four parts to this guide:

### 1. EQUIPMENT

Hosts will require the following list of equipment to set up Zoom or most video services:

#### Internet Connection:

- Broadband Internet connection of at least from 3 to 5 mbps
- Stable connection to wireless router or a direct connection to the internet

#### Microphone(s) (Audio Input):

- In a small group setting, it is recommended to use an additional speaker and microphone setup.
- For an individual, the internal computer microphone is acceptable. Make sure to test this before connecting to the online session.

### Speakers (Audio Output):

- Internal computer speakers are acceptable for an individual participant
- Recommendation for Small Group setting: External speakers

### Webcam (Visual Input):

- Internal computer webcam is acceptable for an individual participant
- Recommendation for Small Group setting: External USB webcam

#### Additional Screen (Visual Output):


- Internal computer screen is acceptable for an individual participant
- Recommendation for Small Group setting: External screen like a monitor or TV



## 2A. BASIC SETUP (1 DEVICE REQUIRED)

A simple hardware setup with common available resources

- 1 Laptop for visual & audio enhancement
  - Visual Output: Laptop to TV using HDMI/VGA Cable
  - Visual Input: Laptop to capture visual of people present
- Audio (input/output)
  For the person sharing, create a hot seat that is positioned front of the TV.






## 2B. INTERMEDIATE SETUP (2 DEVICES REQUIRED)

A software setup with Zoom configurations

- 1 Laptop for visual enhancement
  - Laptop to TV using HDMI Cable to display on screen
  - Laptop to video capture visual of people present at location
- 1 Device for audio enhancement
  - Act as speaker and microphone
  - Example: Another phone/tablet connected to the same zoom meeting
  - You can pass this device around to whoever is sharing/speaking in cell





### **Zoom Configurations**

Note: Some of these settings may not be available if you have not updated your Zoom app, or if your laptop is unable to support these features.




### 1. Make your mic volume louder by changing your audio settings:

- o Turn off "Automatically adjust microphone volume"
- o Set the "Input Volume" slider to maximum
- o If your voice sounds distorted, decrease the "Input Volume" until your voice sounds clear.




### 2. If you are leading worship, change your audio settings:

- o Click on "Advanced" to change the advanced audio settings
- Turn on "Show in-meeting option to "Enable Original Sound" from microphone"
- o Turn on "Disable echo cancellation"
- o Turn on "High fidelity music mode"
- o In the Zoom meeting, click "Turn on Original Sound" in the top left corner of the screen while you are leading worship.
- o After you have finished leading worship, click "Turn off Original Sound"





- 3. If your video is too dark, change your video settings:
  - o Turn on "Adjust for low light"
  - Adjust for low light should be on "Auto" mode. If this is still too dark, change to "Manual" mode and adjust the slider until your video is bright enough.





## **2C. ADVANCED SETUP (MULTIPLE DEVICES REQUIRED)**

A setup that requires additional devices and optional items to be purchased

#### Webcams:

- Scope of len (75 degree and above)
- Lighting (auto correction, minimal back light)

### Recommended 2-in-1 Microphone/Speaker:

- Jabra 410 for USB version only
- Jabra 510 for USB/Bluetooth wireless version (up to 4 people)
- Anker PowerConf for USB/Bluetooth wireless version (up to 6 people)


### 2-in-1 Webcam with built-in Microphone:

- Under \$100: Creative Live! Cam Sync 1080p
- Under \$200: Logitech C930
- Best in market: Logitech Brio 4K Ultra HD




### 3. ADDITIONAL GUIDES & FUNCTIONS

- i. For Video playback:
  - When playing a video using Zoom's "Share Screen" feature, the video is sometimes choppy.
  - SyncTube allows many people watch the same video at the same time e.g. EA service, cell worship video
  - Go to <a href="http://sync-tube.de">http://sync-tube.de</a>



• Click "Create Room"



Copy the YouTube video link into the bar at the top and press enter



- Send the SyncTube link in the address bar (in this example, <a href="https://synctube.de/rooms/lbO4obHi3">https://synctube.de/rooms/lbO4obHi3</a>) to the rest of the cell
- The host who started the SyncTube can control the video playback, e.g. play/pause the video, fast forward
- All other participants who join the SyncTube will watch the YouTube video controlled by the host

#### ii. For Breakout Room:

Breakout room is a built-in zoom function that create virtual rooms for small group discussion

- Recommendation for prayer meeting, micro group discussion
- Good when the meeting have more than 6 participants
