**HOSPITALITY**

Excellent service and heartfelt smiles are what the Hospitality ministry offers to the church family and our visitors. From Carpark Marshals at the church entrance to ushers in the Worship Centre, our joyful and cheery hospitality volunteers are here to ensure you have a pleasant church experience.

## **CAFÉ ASSISTANTS**

More than just serving food and beverages, Café Assistants help to fill the stomachs and hearts of our congregants through food preparation and friendly service.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Friendly and cheerful disposition.

Able to serve at least once a month.

Volunteers will be required to attend a course on food hygiene.

## **COMMUNION PREPARERS**

Prepare communion elements for congregants to partake in the Holy Communion.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Able to serve at least once a month.

Must be able to come to church earlier on days that you serve.

## **FIRST AIDER**

Provide medical assistance when it is needed during services or special services.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Friendly and cheerful disposition.

Able to serve at least once a month.

Must be medically trained and certified.

## **INFORMATION COUNTER ASSISTANTS**

Information Counter Assistants handle enquiries from the church family and our visitors on Sundays.

They also assist in registration of courses, events and seminars.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Able to serve at least once a month after second service.

## **SECURITY PERSONNEL**

Security personnel help to make our church a safe place by keeping watch over the compound and helping in situations requiring security assistance. No professional experience is needed – just a willing heart to serve!

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Friendly and cheerful disposition.

Able to serve at least once a month.

## TRAFFIC MARSHALS

Take this opportunity to work in the frontline!  
Traffic marshals facilitate the flow of vehicles in and out of the church carpark and building. They also look out for those who are in need and assist them to have a seamless church experience.

### *Ministry pre-requisites:*

Friendly and cheerful disposition.  
Able to serve at least twice a month.  
Must be prepared to stand under the sun.

## USHERS

The first point of contact our congregants and visitors have is with our friendly ushers. They make our church family feel welcomed and at home through their warm greetings, friendly handshakes and contagious smiles!

### *Ministry pre-requisites:*

Friendly and cheerful disposition.  
Able to serve at least once a month.

# TECHNICAL & PRODUCTION

T O G E T H E R

The Technical & Production ministry is an integral part of our weekly services. Our volunteers serve in partnership with the Holy Spirit to support an atmosphere of worship that allows our congregants to encounter God.

Criteria for all roles under  
Technical & Production ministry:  
Able to serve at least once a month.

## **AUDIO**

Sound is an important element of every worship service and event. The quality, mix and delivery of sound play a critical role in setting a conducive worship atmosphere. While on-the-job technical coaching will be available to ministry members, having a keen ear and/or musical background would be advantageous.

## **LIGHTING**

Our Lighting Team plays an important role in enhancing the setting for worship at our worship services and events. The Lighting crew will be responsible for providing the appropriate lighting and effects for production, drama and stage presentations. This role requires a “theatrical eye” and a good sense of colours and timing. Basic knowledge of lighting design would be an advantage.

## **LIVE VIDEO**

You will join the team that is responsible for weekly multi-camera production in our English Adult and Youth services as well as special events/projects. The work requires an interesting mix of creative and technical skills. For any live production, there will always be a director, a team of cameramen and a vision mixer.

## **PRODUCTION GRAPHICS**

The graphics crew provides lyric and visual support during worship, sermons as well as other video content during the service/event. Basic computer knowledge is required. Familiarity with our worship songs and Mac Operating System would be an added advantage.

## **STAGE MANAGEMENT**

Swift and resourceful Stage Managers are needed to run our weekly services and church events. The Stage Managers coordinate with various groups of people involved in the service or event, ensuring a seamless flow of the overall programme. Strong people skills, attention to details and a creative inclination would be an advantage.

**(CHILDREN'S MINISTRY)**

SuperLife is the children's ministry of RiverLife and plays the role of supporting parents in teaching and discipling our next generation. SuperLife volunteers sow seeds of faith and invest into the lives of our children so that they may be trained and equipped to walk with obedience and courage in the ways of the Lord.

## **SMALL GROUP TEACHERS**

Much like playing the role of a Cell Leader, our Small Group Teachers speak into the lives of our young ones and teach the Word of God by facilitating discussion during small group time. SuperLife services run every Sunday concurrently with English Adults services at 9am & 11.30am.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

18 years old and above.

Have been a Christian for at least two years.

Passion for children.

Able to serve twice a month for at least one year.

# PASTORAL MINISTRIES

Our pastoral ministries provide pastoral care in various aspects for our church family. These ministries are channels through which God's love and healing can flow.

## 9M MINISTRY

9M Ministry is a support ministry that walks through with expectant mothers for nine months. It is a community of women dedicated to providing spiritual covering over expectant mums through prayer and encouragement, and journey with them through their pregnancy and confinement.

9M ministry volunteers play an important role in providing:

- Encouragement through phone calls or text messages
- Follow-up with expectant mums for each gynae visit and send out prayer requests in chat group for prayer coverage
- Home visitation pregnancy or confinement (*when necessary*)

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Regularly attending cell.

Committed to pray.

## CELL WORD RESOURCE MINISTRY: WRITERS

The ministry offers a resource as an extension of the pulpit-sermons to the cells. Primarily, Cell Guide Writers design a learning tool for members to respond to the teaching of God's Word for life transformation. Using a 4-R framework, writers develop the discussion guide for Word facilitation in cell gatherings. Submission of material for review is on Tuesdays.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Have been a regular worshipper in RiverLife and attending cell for at least one year.

Have the passion to see others grounded and transformed by the Word and Spirit of God.

Able to write well in English and have done facilitation of any kind in group settings.

You will write based on the writers' roster, minimally once a month.

## FAMILY LIFE MINISTRY: MENTOR COUPLES

Our Family Life ministry seeks to support and encourage families to worship God and relate to one another in the way God has purposed in His Word. This ministry helps to build strong and thriving families through initiatives such as Marriage Preparation, Marriage Enrichment, Spiritual Parenting of Young Couples (SPYCes), Child Dedication, Rites Of Passage, and Men's Fellowship.

We are looking for Mentor Couples from various stages of life to support our various Family Life initiatives.

***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Have been a regular worshipper in RiverLife for at least six months. An Associate Member or in the process of attaining Associate Membership.

## **GUEST WELCOME LOUNGE: BEFRIENDERS**

### **Befrienders For First-Time Visitors**

Love meeting and connecting with people from all walks of life? Join our Guest Welcome Lounge as a Befriender! We need volunteers who will give their all to make someone's first visit to RiverLife a memorable one. Befrienders will also assist in serving food and drinks to our visitors.

***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Have been a regular worshipper in RiverLife for at least two years and regularly attending cell. Love meeting new people and able to connect with visitors from all walks of life.

### **Befrienders For Special Needs & Mental Health Care**

We are looking for volunteers to care for those who have special needs or mental health struggles. Volunteers will serve on Sundays after first service for about half an hour. Basic training will be provided.

We welcome non-professionals and professionals in counselling or special needs/mental health care. Experience is a plus but not necessary.

***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Regularly attending cell.  
Able to serve once a month after first service from 11am-11.30am.  
Have a heart for those with special needs and mental health struggles.  
Able to commit for at least one year.

## HOSPITAL VISITATION MINISTRY (HVT)

Hospital Visitation volunteers minister God's love to those who are sick and in need of God's healing touch. HVT ministry is a community of brothers and sisters committed to provide spiritual covering over the sick through prayer and encouragement.

Volunteers visit RiverLifers or their loved ones in the hospital and follow-up with them when necessary. They will also send out prayer requests or updates of the patient in chat group for prayer coverage.

### ***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Regularly attending cell.

Committed to pray and do hospital visitation

(every member will be assigned to one hospital, once a week).

Our BLESS Befrienders will build relationship with our BLESS programme recipients and reach out through buying groceries for them on a monthly basis.

***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Able to serve monthly. Scheduling will be between befrienders and families.

Able to commit for at least one year.

If you do not own a car, you may have to take a cab to deliver the groceries.

## YOUTH CLUB BEFRIENDERS

Our Youth Club Befrienders interact and engage with the youths that we are reaching out to. There are regular outings and sports activities for the youths on Saturday mornings; and youth meetings every Thursday at 3-5pm.

***Ministry pre-requisites:***

Able to serve twice a month on Saturday mornings or on Thursdays from 3-5pm.

Consistency and regularity of our volunteers will be very helpful in doing a deeper work in the lives of our youths.
